Center for Health Improvement

The Center for Health Improvement is a 92,000 square foot facility that houses a 2-lane indoor track, **Three Indoor Pools**, a group fitness studio, a multi-purpose room, education room, community health library, a full size gym and a play center for kids. It features two floors of weight machines and cardiovascular equipment. Take advantage of the Cardio Theatre system by watching television or listening to music while working out. A Wellness Specialist is always available to help with any questions. The Center provides a choice of free weights or Magnum weight machines which will help achieve a maximum workout.

The **Pro-Shop and Juice Bar** located within The Center provide a wholesome environment. Grab a bite to eat or enjoy a cup of coffee by stopping by the juice bar X-press lounge. The Pro-Shop offers swimsuits and various equipment to help improve a workout.

The Locker Rooms are first class, with private showers, basic grooming products, clean towels, hair dryers and a variety of other products, allowing users to head straight back to the office, run errands or go home and relax after a great workout. FHSU's Sternberg Museum of Natural History

At this four-story dome museum, you will experience a recreated day 88 million years ago when the mighty Tyrannosaurus Rex haunted the land and an Inland Sea covered Kansas.

Visitors can walk among semi-automated life-sized dinosaurs in a fully restored environment and experience the life of some of the most spectacular creatures that ever lived. The large array of fossils the Sternberg Family found through their studies is on display, including the famous "fish-within-a-fish."

Museum features include a replicated fossil dig site and a discovery room with hands-on activities.

Ellis County Historical Museum

View Ellis County history from the frontier era through today. Visit the Saloon and learn to play faro, a popular card game in the Old West. The Discovery Center for children of all ages (located in the balcony) is open for learning fun with vintage clothes to try on, old time toys, farm animals, diorama and much more. The Stone Church, built in 1879, is the oldest existing church building in Ellis County. Visit the Museum Store and take home some Kansas souvenirs. The museum grounds also include: Younger Harness Shop, an original store from the early 1900s; replica Volga German Haus, tells the story of Ellis County's largest immigrant group; and Hays Fire Department Museum, replicated after the fire station that was located in Hays beginning in 1927.

Pick up a Walking Tour brochure while in the area. Tour at your convenience down the streets of historic downtown Hays. On one of the walking tours, be taken back to the Wild West era of early Hays. In the other tour, various buildings have been restored and new businesses brought into what is called the Chestnut Street District, a name that pays homage to the former name of Main Street (which was Chestnut Street until 1929). Enjoy learning the history of these buildings.

Moss-Thorns Art Gallery

For many years, the Department of Art and Design was spread out among a number of buildings and never had a formal gallery. In 1969, John C. Thorns, Jr. first presented his vision to the college administration for a regional art museum with educational laboratories to house the Department of Art. With the completion of Rarick Hall in the spring of 1981, Thorns' vision was realized.

Historic Fort Hays

Congressional Medal of Honor recipient Sergeant John Denny served at Fort Hays from January 1882 to December 1884. He and other African American “Buffalo Soldiers” are part of the rich Fort Hays history that includes names like Generals George A. Custer, Nelson Miles, Philip Sheridan, Major Marcus Reno, William “Buffalo Bill” Cody and James B. “Wild Bill” Hickok. Established in 1865 in the land of the Cheyenne and Arapaho, the fort protected railroad workers and travelers on the Smoky Hill Trail. See the soldiers’ clothing, weapons and personal items, including George Custer’s dumbbell forged by the fort’s blacksmith. Learn more about the soldiers and the people they were protecting when visiting Old Fort Hays.

Historic Downtown Chestnut Street District

The Chestnut Street District is the center of the Hays community and follows the original footprint of Chestnut Street prior to 1929, when it was renamed to Main Street. The district is bursting with energy and new vitality. A portion of the district is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Its restored historical and architectural ambiance creates a culturally unique destination. A cornerstone of the district is the Carnegie-inspired public library, rated as one of the top five libraries in the nation.

While you will no longer find a street named Chestnut, look for one of the three gateway markers memorializing the district as you enter the downtown to know you’ve arrived. Located at the corners of Eighth and Fort, Eighth and Oak, and Seventeenth and Main, each marker was designed and built by local artist, Pete Felten.
