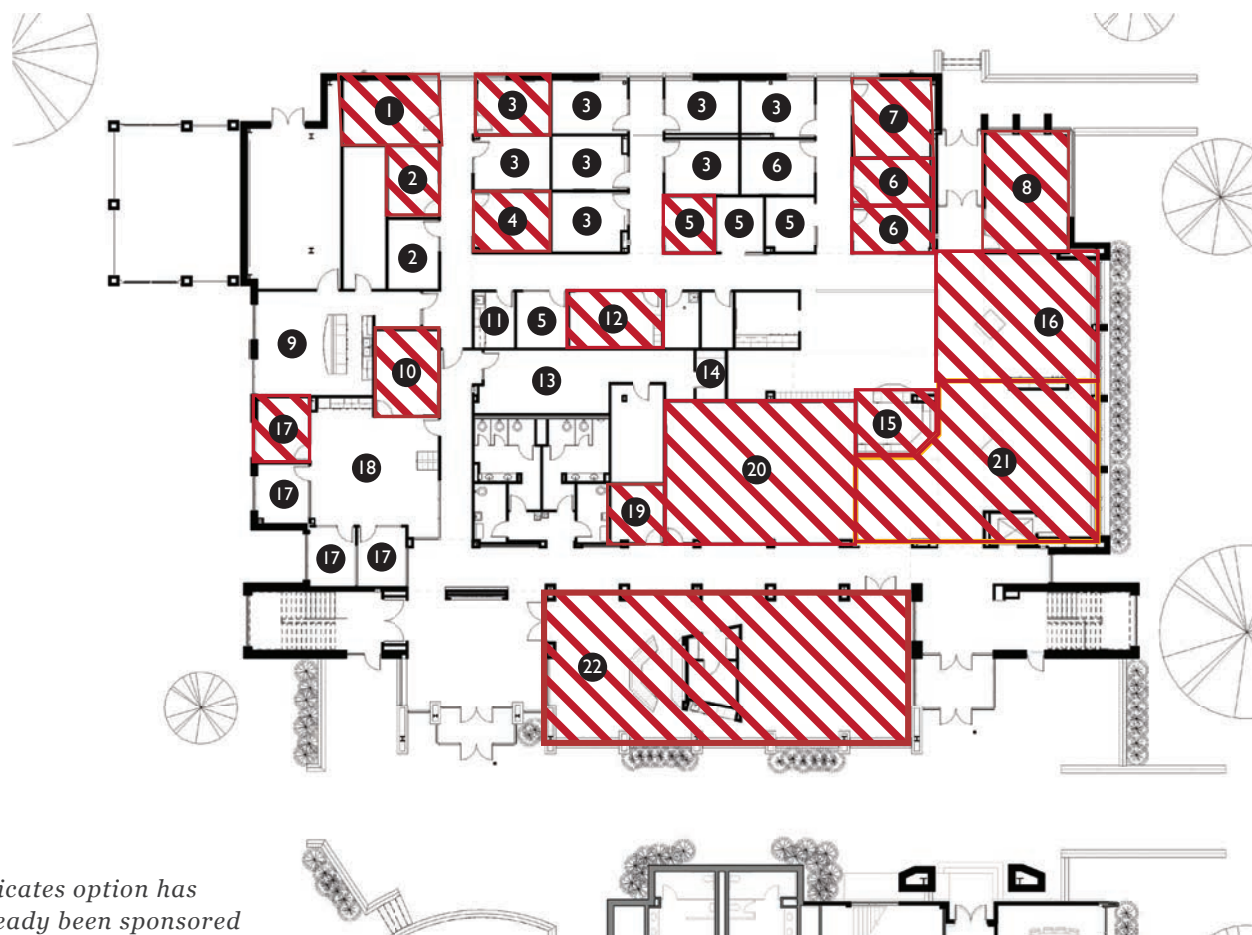

The first floor offers a new student welcome center, career and academic advising services, and freshman seminar space.

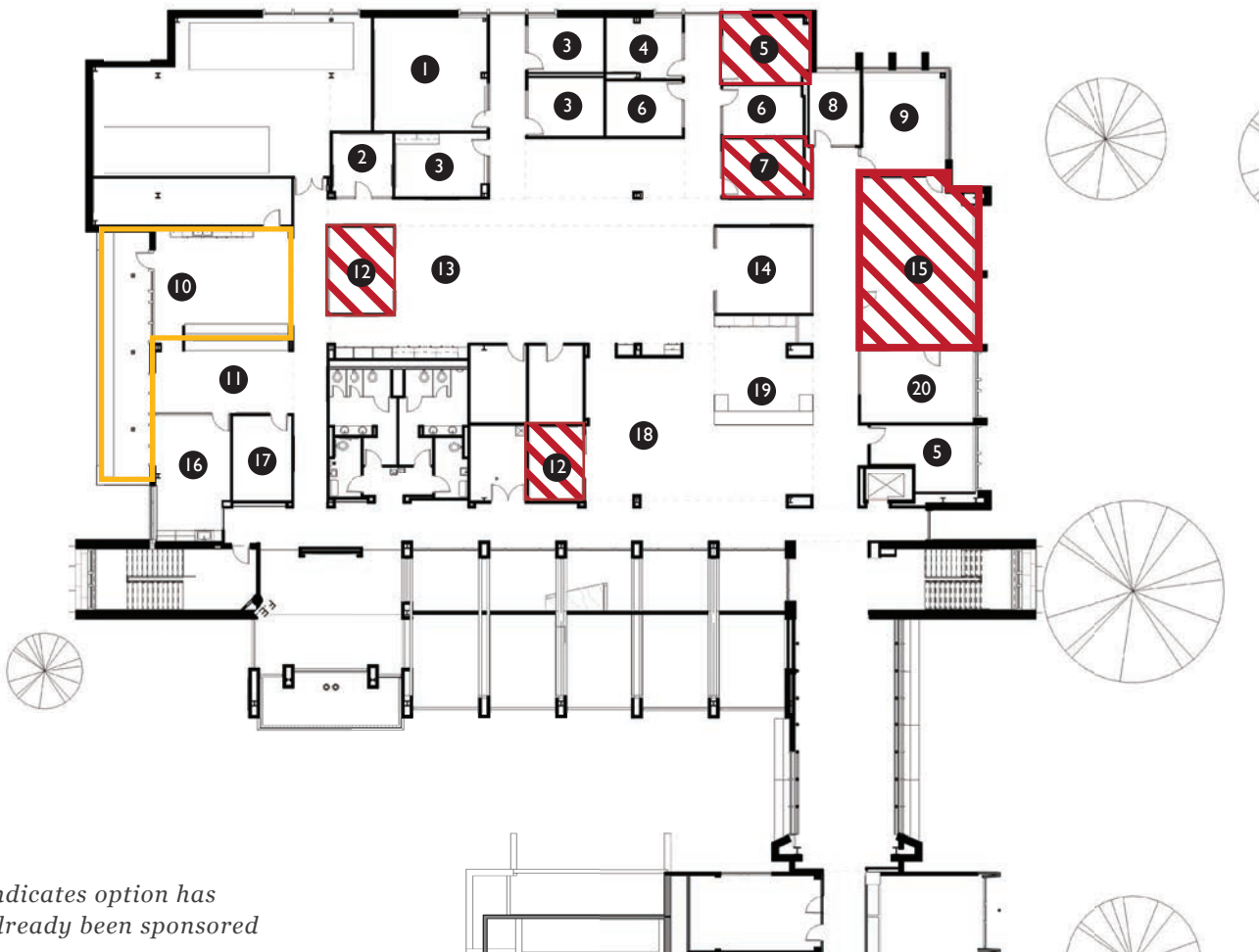

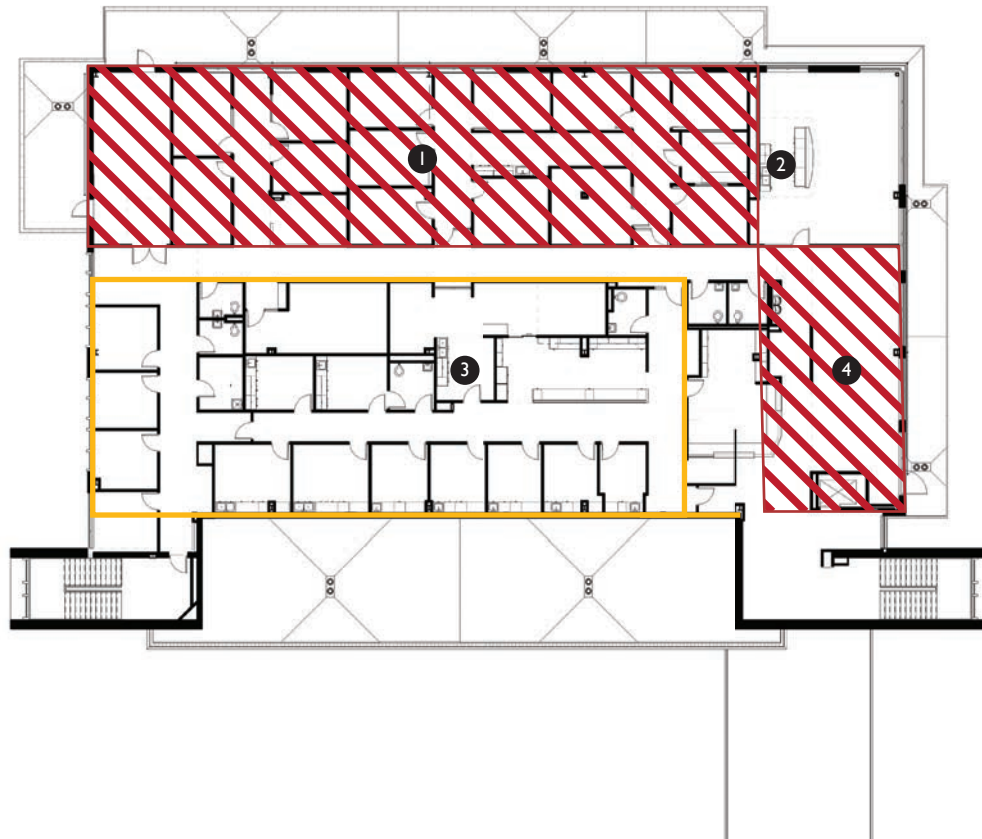
